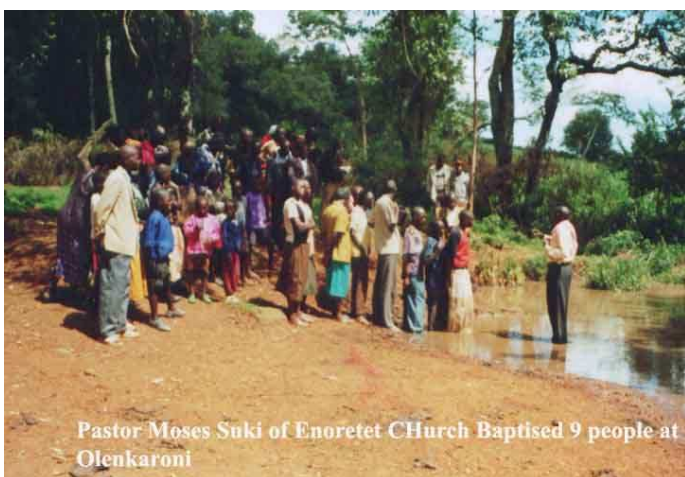

A Sabbath day meeting of two churches coming together to worship.



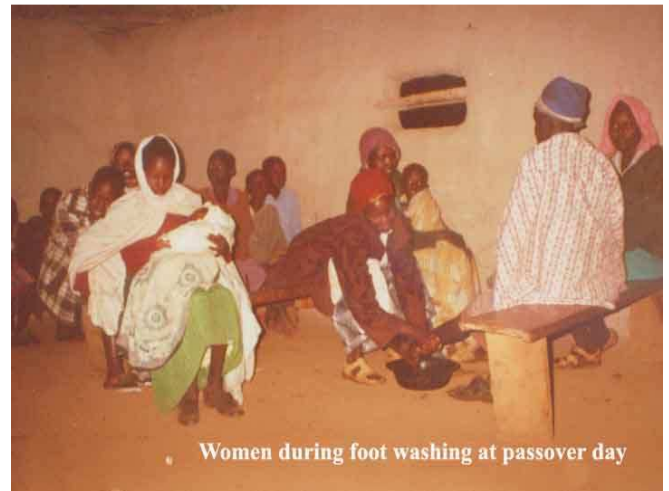

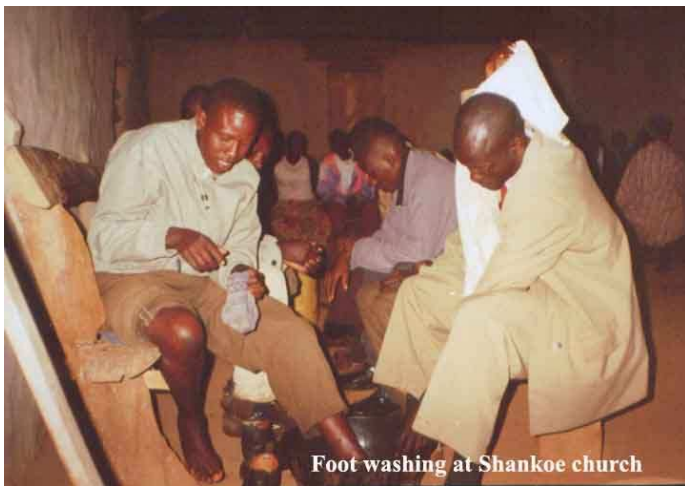
Pastor Moses Suki of Enoretet Church Baptised 9 people at Olenkaroni

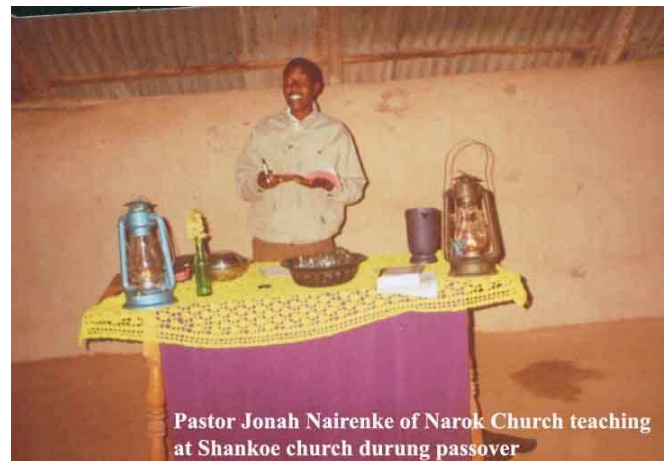
Some kept Passover for the very first time this year. Here a group of women participate in the foot washing ceremony – John 13:1-20
