

One Religion In The Kingdom of God

You do not have to be a bible scholar to learn that much of the Bible is about the coming Kingdom of God. Much of the book of Isaiah tells us of the 1000 years when Jesus Christ will rule this earth from his capital city Jerusalem, assisted by his saints Revelation 20:4. It is from Jerusalem that the whole world will learn of God's law – the Biblical way that will result in peace, prosperity and happiness for all mankind. Isaiah 2:2-4.

Jesus followed his cousin John the Baptist. Both of them came with the same message- Matthew 3:2, 4:17. When the disciples asked Jesus about His return in Mark 13 He gave a list of events that would precede His coming but then said Mark 13:10. All mankind will hear of His return to establish His Kingdom at the very beginning of these troubles, which will all occur in one generation (verse 30). Many of us have helped deliver this message to the world, but it will only be finally achieved by divine intervention - Revelation 14:6-7. Yes, every man woman and child worldwide will be told about Christ's coming return. (See our article Preached Into All The World).

Isaiah 11 gives us a wonderful picture of God's Kingdom. Jesus Christ is 'a rod out of the stem of Jesse (verse one) who was His ancestor. He will judge the earth in righteousness and tolerate no evil (verse 4). All nature, wildlife, and mankind will live in peace and harmony, based upon the knowledge of God's way of life found in the Bible (verse 9).

All the world will come to learn from Jerusalem v10 and the remnants of the scattered nations of Israel, descendants of the 12 tribes – not just Judah (Ancient Israel ended up in NW Europe, Britain, and from there to America, Canada, Australia and South Africa) will be gathered from the four corners of the earth back to the land of their ancestors verses 11-13. This will be a second Exodus, for very few will survive the troubles that lead up to the final battle of Armagedon.

The surrounding nations will then obey the laws of Israel's God verse 14, who will display His power to any who will not keep His Holy Days, Zechariah 14: 16-17. Any nation refusing will receive no rain verse 17. Nations such as Egypt who get little rain anyway, and depend on the Nile, will be punished with plague if their representatives fail to go to Jerusalem to keep the Feats of Tabernacles !

The Ten Commandments are the basis of God's Law. Exodus 20:1-17, which will be spread worldwide to all nations by God's ambassadors Isaiah 66:19. One day only each week will be observed worldwide as God's Holy Day – the Sabbath, Isaiah 66:23, the seventh day of the week Exodus 20:8-11.

People will come to understand that God the Father and Jesus Christ together formed their Plan for mankind, Genesis 1:26.

Jesus said "I and my Father are one". He was the executive arm of God who led ancient Israel through the wilderness 1Corinthians 10:1-4. During the millennium He alone will rule in His Fathers name, with the help of the saints (not the Roman Catholic type, but those Christians down the ages who make up the 144,000 firstfruits,) Revelation 14:1,4.

All men, of all nations will learn to look to Jesus Christ, if they want eternal life Acts 4:12, even as, in truth, it is today. Satan and his false religions, which have been the cause of so much violence and suffering on this earth will be banished for 1000 years Revelation 20:2-3. This will be the start of one true religion here on Earth, with one King of Kings (Revelation 19:7,16) before whom **every** knee shall bow Romans 14:11).
